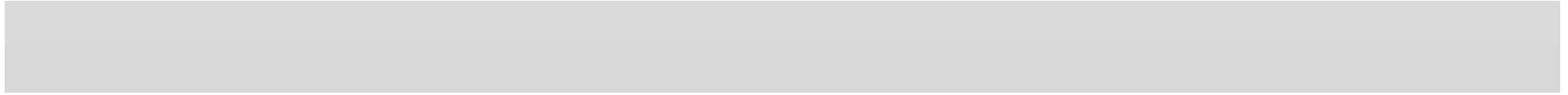

BY FUNDING SOURCE FISCAL YEAR 2016



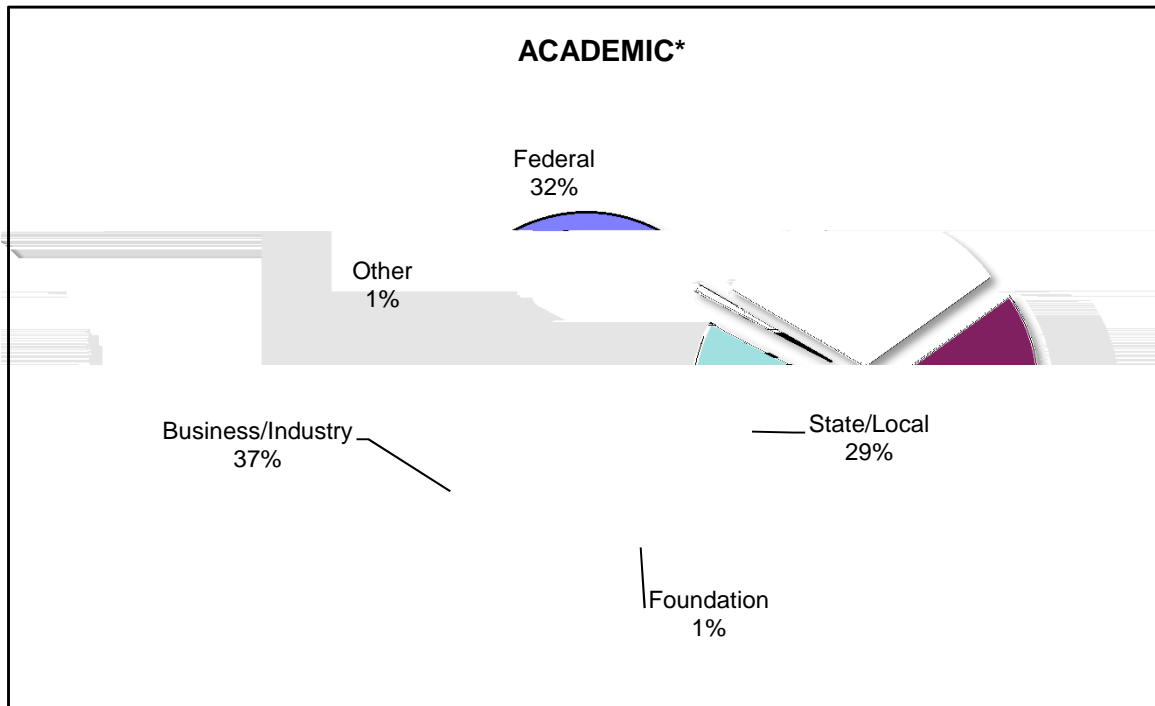

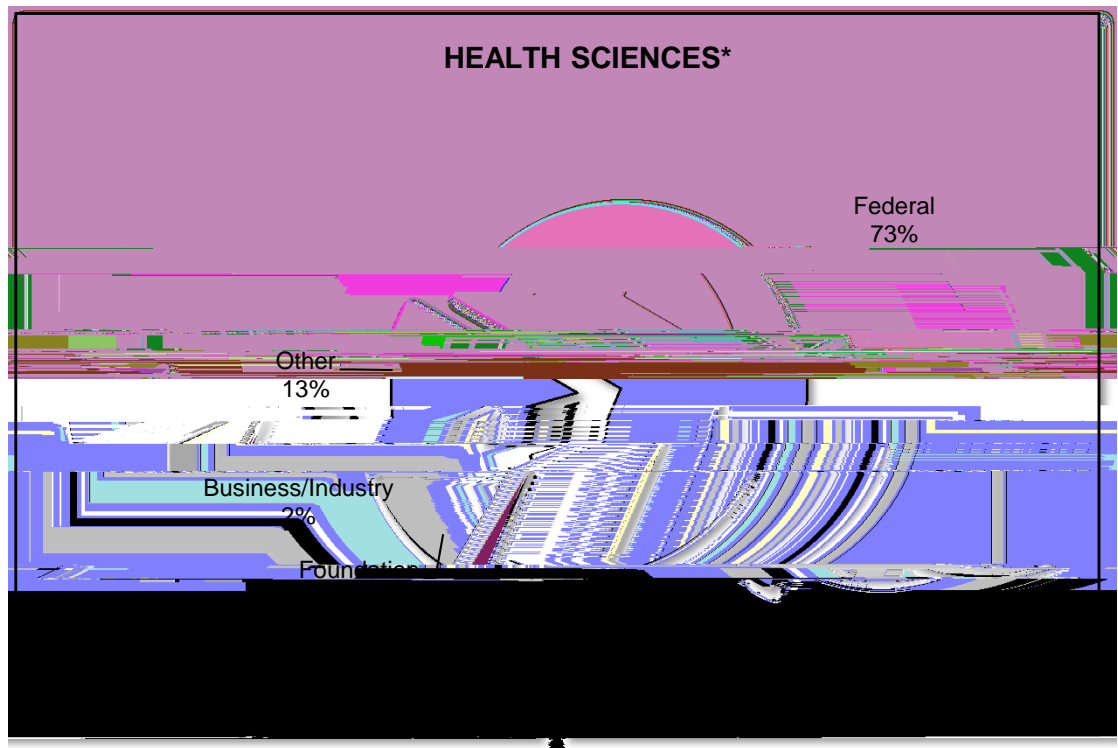
DISTRIBUTION OF SPONSORED FUNDING

BY FUNDING SOURCE FISCAL YEAR 2016

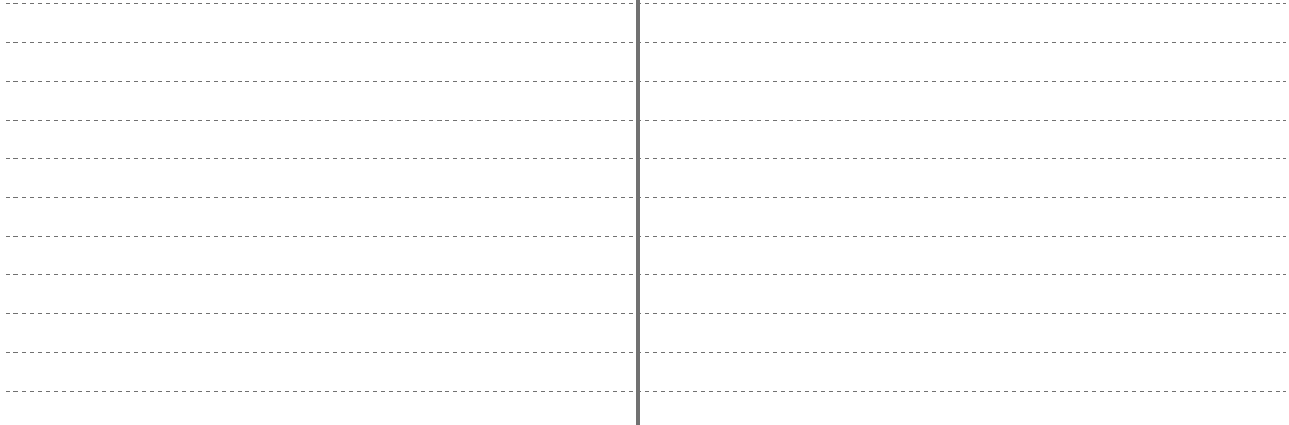

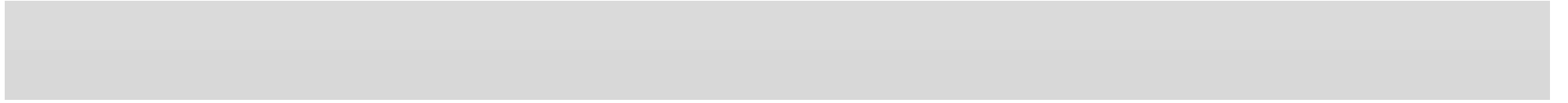

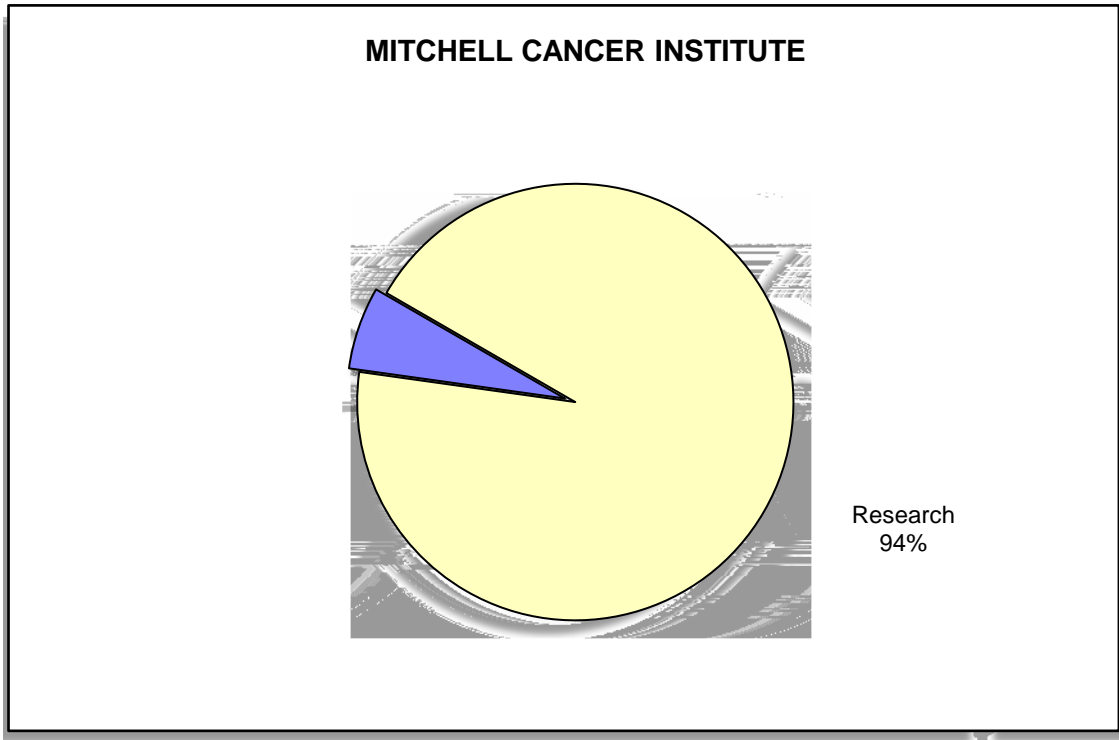


**DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS

BY FUNDING PURPOSE FISCAL YEAR 2016



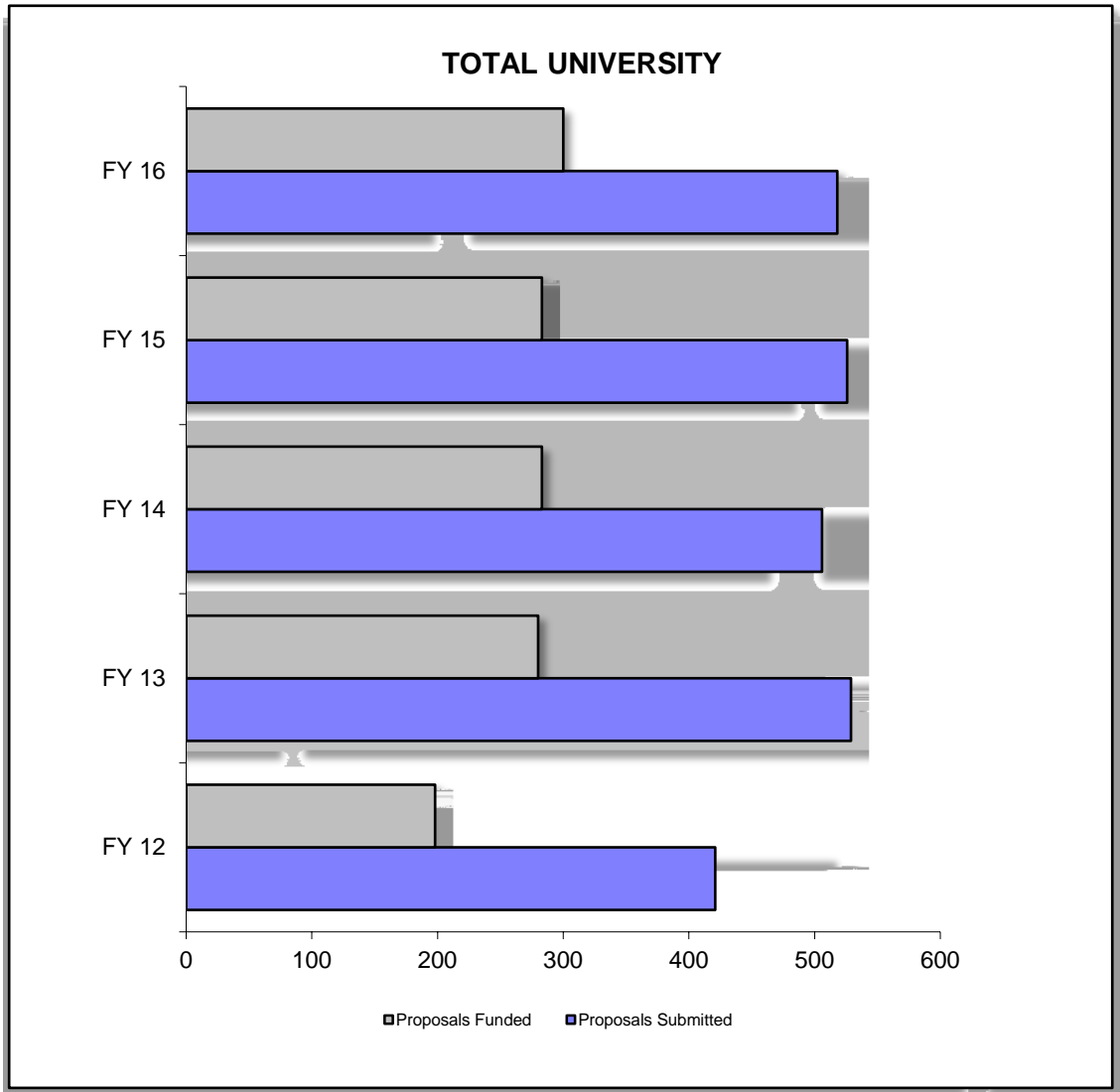

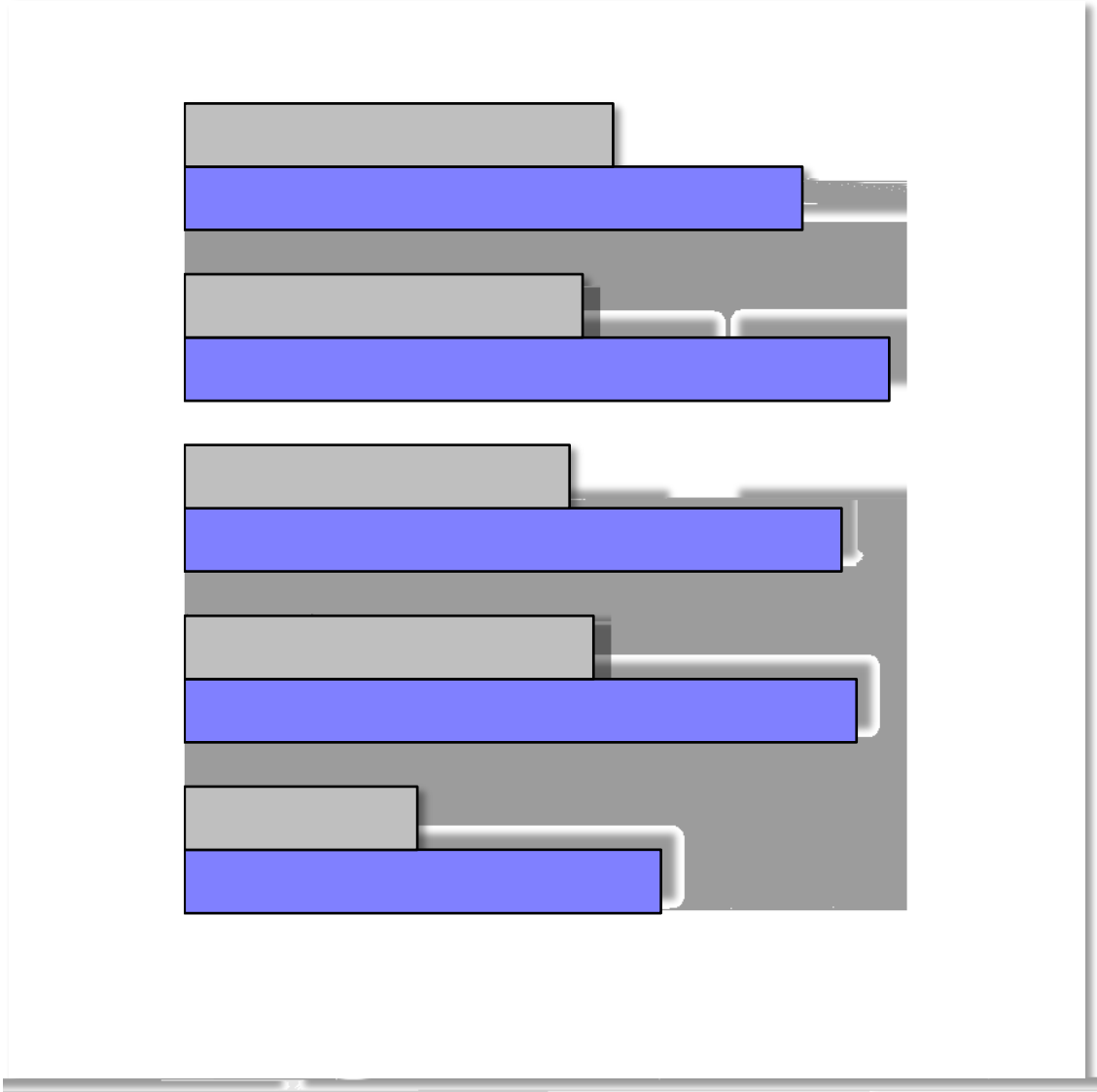

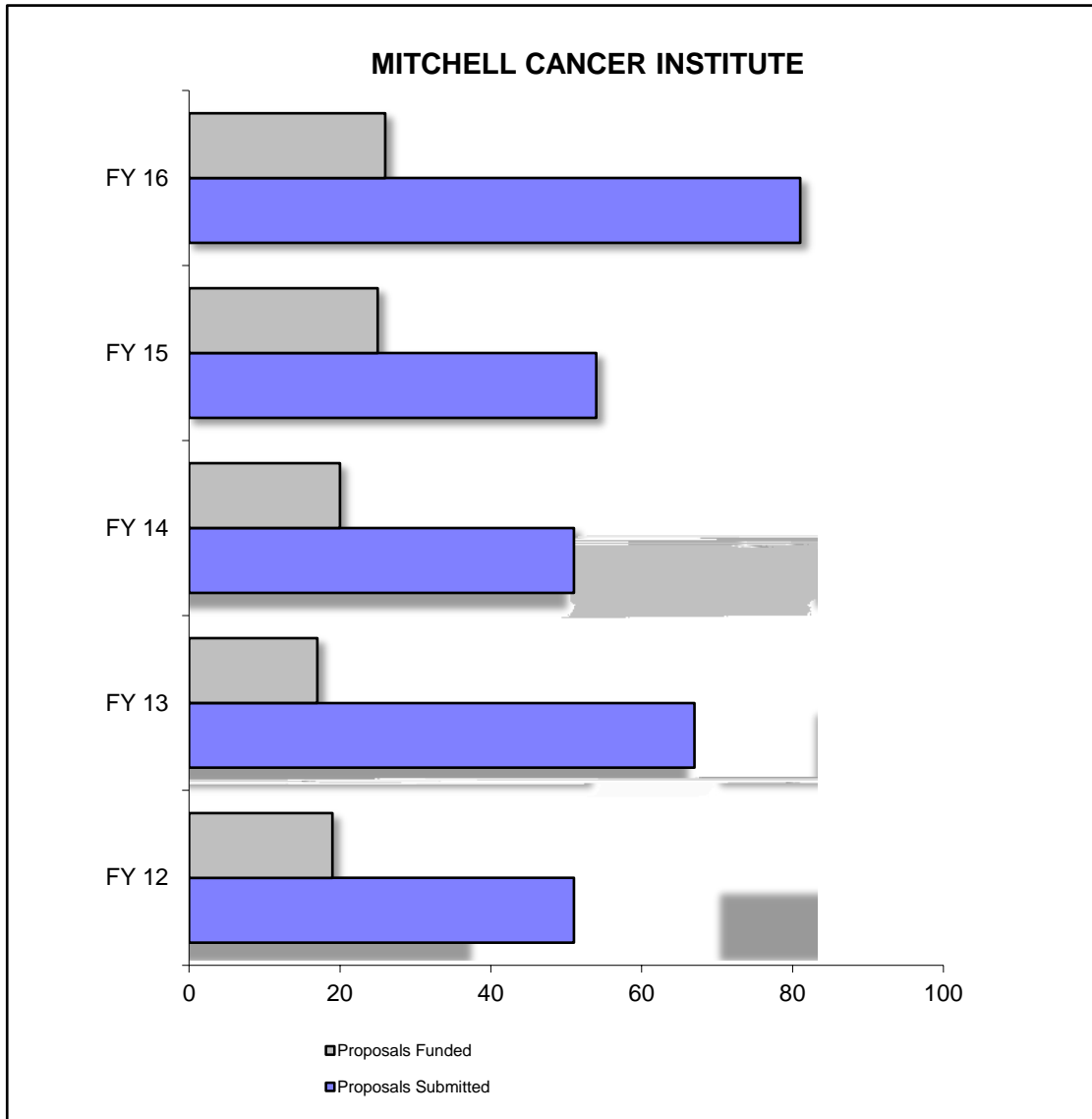
